Selection Process

- After the deadline, our team will review all applications.
- Candidates may be invited for a brief online interview.
- Successful applicants will be notified by 15 April 2024.

Costs and Commitment

Depending on your role and level of commitment, meals, local transportation, and potentially accommodation will be provided. You will be required to cover the cost of your travel to and from Incheon International Airport (ICN).

Volunteers should plan to be available to be on the ground in Incheon between 19–30 September 2024. The specific dates that each volunteer will be needed will be confirmed by their team lead in March 2024.
